

Rann Utsav started as a three-day celebration continuously developed into a 100-day festivity at Dhordo, a town close to Rann of Kutch where an entirely different makeshift camp has been made, loaded with impermanent framework fabricated and revamped consistently.

Rann Utsav is one of the most enthusiastically awaited occasion for travel in India, which praises the wonders of nature at the White Desert and the rich social and creative legacy of Kutch. The idea of Rann Utsav was imagined by Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi.

Detailed Itinerary

Day 01 (26th Jan): Bengaluru to Pune, Distance: 850 Kms, Flag off time: 5.30 AM

We start our Journey from Bengaluru from a common meet up point and proceed towards Pune. Stray overnight in Pune in super deluxe hotel.

Day 02 (27th Jan): Pune to Kevadia, Distance: 500 Kms, Flag off time: 8.30 AM

Here we visit The Statue of Unity is the world's tallest statue at 182 metres (597 ft). It rises 54 metres (177 ft) higher than the previous record holder, the Spring Temple Buddha in China's Henan province. The previous tallest statue in India was the 41 m (135 ft). The monument is constructed on a river island named Sadhu Bet, 3.2 km away from and facing the Narmada Dam downstream. The statue and its surroundings occupy more than 2 hectares, and are surrounded by a 12 km long artificial lake formed by the Garudeshwar weir downstream on the Narmada river.

Day 03 (28th Jan): Kevadia to Ahmedabad, Distance: 200 Kms, Flag Off time: 8.30 AM

Here we start our journey towards Ahmedabad, the heart of Gujarat, while we explore possible places on the way and experience real culture and food of Gujarat. Upon reaching the destination explore famous places of Ahmedabad have dinner and rest.

People joining only for **Gujarat** will merge today with the team from Ahmedabad

Day 04 (29th Jan): Ahmedabad To Gir, Distance: 325 Kms, Flag Off time: 8.00 AM

After Breakfast we start our journey towards Gir national Park. Stay Overnight at a jungle resort within the forest range.

Day 05 (30th Jan) :- Gir Lion Safari & Local,

A day to experience Jungle Safari in the Morning. Gir National Park is famous for Asiatic Lions found only in Gir, Gujarat.

Post Lion Safari we do Breakfast and relax at the resort.

Day 06 (31st Jan): - Gir To Dwarka Via Somnath, Distance: 290 Kms, Flag Off time: 8.00 AM

Today we start our journey towards Somnath: famous for **Shree Somnath Jyotirlinga Temple**. Today we will visit Somnath Temple & Porbandar and then Spend the evening on the Porbandar beach followed by Dwarka.

Today the drive is via Porbandar, the birth place of Mahatma Gandhi. After reaching Dwarka we explore Ancient Dwaraka Nagari, the city of Lord Krishna. Upon reaching we go to Dwarkadhish Temple for night darshan then to the Hotel, have dinner and rest for the day.

Day 07 (1st Feb):- Dwarka To Bhuj, Distance: 400 Kms, Flag Off time: 8.00 AM

A day to reach Kutch district which has a history and **Bhuj** is also part of Kutch. Today we will experience sunset at famous Mandavi beach and Windmill farm. This is one of the westernmost Sunset Point of India. In evening we explore local Market and post dinner take rest.

Day 08 (2nd Feb): Bhuj to Rann of Kutch: (City Of Tents), Distance: 85 kms, Flag off: 8.30 AM

After Breakfast we head towards White desert of Rann, the final destination where Rann Utsav is being celebrated. We will explore white desert and after enjoying the most beautiful sunset of white Rann, we will witness cultural Gujrati programs and will take rest into Swiss Ac Tents.

Day 09 (3rd Feb): Rann of Kutch To Bhuj, Distance: around 150 kms, Flag off: 8.30 AM

Today after breakfast it's time to explore western part of Kutch district, where we explore, Harappan civilization, Black Mountain, Zero Point, Magnetic Hill, forts, and many more ancient tourist attraction.

Overnight stay in Bhuj.

Those who join only for Gujarat will take a leave after reaching Ahmadabad.

Day 10 (4th Feb): Bhuj to Ahmedabad, Distance: 330 Kms, Flag off: 8.30 AM

After Breakfast we drive towards Ahmedabad, Take a night halt in Ahmedabad, Explore local market and take night rest.

Day 11 (5th Feb): Ahmedabad to Nashik, Distance: 480 Kms

After breakfast, we drive towards Spiritual city Nashik which is in Maharashtra state. We Visit Jyotirlinga in Nashik for darshan.

Day 12 (6th Feb) : Nashik to Hampi, Distance: 780 kms

After an early breakfast, we head out towards Hampi, Hospet.


Day 13 (7th Feb): Hampi To Bangalore, Distance: 325 kms

Payments: For all the services contracted, certain advance payment should be made to hold the booking, on confirmed basis & the balance amount can be paid either before your departure from your country or upon arrival in INDIA but definitely before the commencement of the services.
